UNIPLAC turned 60 years old in 2019. It is a reference to high-quality instruction in Higher Education, committed to regional development, and a source of pride for those who have been and are part of it. Its history began with the "Catarinense Association of Culture", created in July 1959 and declared of public service in November of that same year.

UNIPLAC has a total land area of 78,455.70 m² and a built area of 35,827.03 m², which corresponds to several buildings with 188 classrooms, administrative offices, library, laboratories, Exact and Technological Sciences Center, Heath Center, restrooms facilities, as well as, accommodations for people with special needs.

The Postgraduate Program in Environment and Health Concentration area: Environment and Health

Research Line 1 - Health, Environment and Society

Analyze and expand the understanding of conditions, situations, and lifestyles in their interactions with the environment and health, as complex and multidimensional themes. The topics covered in this line are directed toward integrative actions, and strategies for interdisciplinary promotion, prevention and intervention aimed at minimizing inequities, and socio-environmental asymmetries, and improving the quality of life, safety, and the well-being of society, with emphasis on regional aspects.





Concentration area: Environment and Health

Research Line 1 - Health, Environment and Society

Health and socio-environmental education, workers' health and work organizations, production processes, and their impacts on the ecosystem and on the management of issues related to health, the environment, and wellbeing in urban and rural contexts also constitute proposals to be developed.





Concentration area: Environment and Health

Research Line 2 – Environment, Sustainability and Health Implications

This research line investigates the impacts of living conditions and human activities on natural resources, environmental health, ecological functions, biodiversity, agrifood systems, and their health implications. Study production processes, innovation environments, and their effects on ecosystems in urban and rural contexts. In an interdisciplinary manner, this line of research is towards actions and strategies of prevention, intervention, and promotion of sustainable models of territorial occupation, maintaining ecosystem services, meeting food/nutritional security, and collective health.













Concentration area: Environment and Health

Research Line 2 – Environment, Sustainability and Health Implications

It also researches the interrelationship between environmental, human, and animal health (One Health), waste management, environmental contamination, parasite ecopidemiology, environmental education, environmental management and legislation, environmental quality bioindicators, plant health, and integrative homeopathy. It seeks to encourage research from innovative theoretical perspectives that can have an impact on economic, technological, political, social, and environmental development in different types of organizations.















The Postgraduate Program in Environment and Health International Symposium on Science, Health and Territorial

The International Symposium Science, Health, and Territory happens every two years, with six editions so far. In all editions, there was financial support from funding agencies such as FAPESC and/or CAPES. In each edition of the event, different themes are addressed. The themes seek to work strategies for interdisciplinary actions in the relationship between environment, and health with renowned national and international speakers, and integrate researchers, professors, students, professionals from different areas, technicians and the community in general for the discussions. During the event, lectures, round tables, mini-courses, presentations of scientific works as well as, photographic exhibitions are offered. The scientific works presented during the event are published in Annals of the Symposium.
